## Intro:

C and F x4

## Verse 1:

C F  
I've been trying to do it right  
C F  
I've been living the lonely life  
C F  
I've been sleeping here instead  
C  
I've been sleeping in my bed  
Am G F  
I've been sleeping in my bed  
C and F x2 (instrumental)

## Verse 2:

C  
So show me family  
And all the blood that I will bleed  
I don't know where I belong  
I don't know where I went wrong  
But I can write a song.  
C

## Chorus:

Am G C  
I belong with you, you belong with me, you're my sweetheart  
Am G C  
I belong with you, you belong with me, you're my sweet  
C and F x4 (same as intro)

## Verse 3:

Am G F C  
I don't think you're right for him  
Think of what it might've been if you  
Took a bus to Chinatown  
I'd be standing on Canal...  
... and Bowery  
Am G F C  
And she'd be standing next to me

## Chorus

### Bridge: (same strum as chorus)

F G C  
And love, we need it now  
F G  
Let's hope for some  
F G C  
Cuz oh, we're bleeding out

## Last chorus:

I belong with you, you belong with me, you're my sweetheart  
I belong with you, you belong with me, you're my sweet  
C and F x4 (same as intro)

## Strum for intro and verse, very light and syncopated:

1 + 2 + 3 + 4 + 1 + 2 + 3 + 4 +  
d d u u d u d  
1 3 and and2 and4

You play F (which is actually Fmaj7) on the last underlined "ud" on the above pattern.

The end of the verse (last line), this is how you have to place your chords below, the pattern is slightly different at the end:

1 + 2 + 3 + 4 + 1 + 2 + 3 + 4 +  
d d u u d d d  
Am G F

## Strum for Chorus:

1 + 2 + 3 + 4 + 1 + 2 + 3 + 4 +  
d d u d u d d u d u  
1 2 and4and1 2 and4and  
Am G

C then, takes the entire pattern. The bridge has the same strum.
