Nice easy song, no difficulties there, it has to be played fast enough. The first down is on the bass strings. It's an easy song if you want to play and sing at the same time.

The intro and 1<sup>st</sup> verse can be slightly arpeggiated (plucked), even with the pick, then you play the rest of the song with a proper strumming.
